This VISA support is for those who plan to enter the country on a 'Business Visa'. Please prepare your own documents for a 'Tourist Visa'. If a participant requires a 'Business Visa' to enter Japan, please fill out the VISA Support form with 'yes' and 'no' if a 'Tourist Visa' is required.

Please note that obtaining a 'Business Visa' requires specific documents. Therefore, we kindly request you to download and fill out the 'VISA Support form.xlsx' available in the application form. Along with this, please upload a copy of your passport to the designated section within the application form. Once we have reviewed the information regarding your planned flight and hotel stay, our support team will send you the necessary documents via email.

Please be aware that the time required for the application and issuance of a VISA varies depending on the country. Therefore, we kindly advise you to apply as early as possible.

Please NOTE that the VISA support requires a support fee.

If a participant cancels his/her participation for any reason, the VISA support fee will not be refunded, even if the cancellation is made during the period when no cancellation fee is charged.

Measures to prevent the spread of infection

Infection prevention measures should follow the government or Sapporo Teishinkai Hospital's infection contorol rules, depending on the situation at the time

OR Observation

The live observation in the operating room is meaningful from an educational perspective and has been one of the most important sections of the FEN Sapporo Live Course.

We are planning to have the OR observation this year whilst considering the potential spread of infection and personal data protection for the patients. Therefore, all participants will be required to strictly follow the rules of the OR as outlined below;

-You can only enter the OR based on the planned schedule and designated groups.

-Only enter the OR round when you are with your tutor.

-Unfortunately the OR round schedule and groupings could seem unfair because it depends on both the schedule and progression of cases. We apologize in advance if this does happen.

-Give consideration to the staff and patients in Sapporo Teishinkai Hospital. Please remember it is a general hospital where daily operations are conducted in other departments.

-Do not upload data and pictures with information on patients to SNS, Facebook or any other social media platforms.

-Sharing any of the images, videos, or personal information presented in this Live Course is strictly prohibited.

-Uploading any information provided in this Live Course to the internet including SNS, is strictly prohibited.

-No cell phones / smart phones are allowed to bring to the operating room.

*If participants mistakenly carry them to the operating room, B.Braun Aesculap staff will look after until participants leave the room.

-Private conversations, questions, and discussions with the surgeon and operating room nurses are prohibited.

-Pay the utmost care and attention to the classification of clean /unclean areas.

Please note that the above measures are as a result of issues occurring from participants who attended the course in recent years. Please be reminded that if just one participant doesn't observe the rules the Chairman reserves the right to cancel the OR observation immediately, no matter what stage in proceedings, without refund. If you are unable to follow the above rules your participation in future courses will not be accepted.

*Since the Japan Neurosurgical Society prohibits live broadcasting of surgical images, it is not possible to provide live streaming via web, etc.; so, the participants will only be able to observe the live images in the main conference room of Sapporo Teishinkai Hospital.
