Here along the banks of the River Liffey – you will find state of the art hotels, venues and the convention centre rising above Viking laneways and cobbled Georgian Streets.

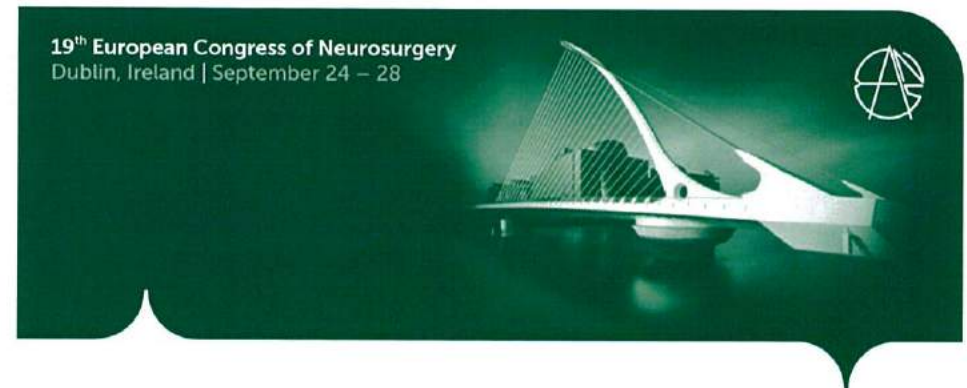
